As most of us know, we have been receiving calls from clients on whether or not we could honor expiry dates or not. As we said it was not St. John Ambulance's call to make, so the director of training applied for an extension with OH&S and it was granted. I have attached the paperwork provided to say that the extension was granted so you can pass it along to any clients that call and ask. As of March 19, 2020 whoever's first aid expires from now until September 18, 2020 will be granted the extension until September 21, 2020. I hope this helps some of your clients as I know a lot of them have postponed training until the COVID-19 crisis is over. Feel free to email me back with any questions you may have or you can call the office Monday and talk to Rose. We are closed to the public starting Monday so please do not go down to the office to talk to Rose about it as she is not allowed to let you in. Thanks and have a great day!
