EXEMPTION FROM REGULATIONS

BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISION MADE IN SECTION 3-85 OF *THE SASKATCHEWAN EMPLOYMENT ACT* AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FACT THAT THE SAFETY OR HEALTH OF PERSONS WORKING AT THE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT OF:

St. John Ambulance various locations

WILL NOT BE MATERIALLY AFFECTED AND THAT INTERESTED PERSONS HAVE BEEN CONSULTED, I HEREBY DIRECT:

The requirements of clause 55(2)(a) of *The Occupational Health and Safety Regulations*, 1996 (the "regulations") do not apply to first aid certificates issued by St. John Ambulance.

SUBJECT TO THESE CONDITIONS:

- 1. This exemption only applies to first aid certificates issued by St. John Ambulance that have their validity expire between 12:00 am on March 19, 2020 and 11:59 pm on September 18, 2020.
- 2. First aid certificates issued by St. John Ambulance that have their validity expire between 12:00 am on March 19, 2020 and 11:59 pm on September 18, 2020 will have their validity extended to September 21, 2020.

AND FOR THESE REASONS:

- 1. The validity of first aid certifications issued by St. John Ambulance will be extended in order to respond to the COVID-19 viral outbreak in Saskatchewan.
- 2. The standard of health and safety of any worker will not be materially affected by this exemption.

EXPIRY AND REVOCATION:

This exemption may be revoked by the Director at any time without notice. Unless sooner revoked, this exemption shall expire on September 21, 2020.
