

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Effective November 16, 2020 masks became mandatory in all public places in Lloydminster.

CANSAFE is very aware that there are many people who do not want to wear a mask. Unfortunately, until the mandate changes we must follow the rules as provided by the Province of Saskatchewan.

As per the *Re-open Saskatchewan* plan and by the province's Public Health Order, masks are mandatory in public places. Through consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority and the City of Lloydminster, CANSAFE is considered a public place, and masks must be worn. Anyone who is found to be in violation of the public health order can be charged by local or provincial authorities.

Employees of CANSAFE will be following the rules and we expect students coming to CANSAFE to do so as well. Should individuals refuse to wear a mask we will be asking them to leave the premises.

This is a very contentious issue. CANSAFE is not disputing the fact that individuals have a right to make a stand. What we are requesting is should you wish to make that stand please go to the appropriate venue where it will make a difference and do not put us at risk or in the position of having to ask you to leave.
